Finally I was so fed up with filling out form after form, of the same redundant questionnaires; I decided to do something about it. After 3 years of development we created our solution, a mobile app called "My Medical HistoryQR; Play Store, My All Medical HistoryQR iTunes. Our app allows a person to securely store their medical history, and medication they are currently taking in their phone. The data is not saved in a database or cloud, but in their own phone. It is password protected, and in addition, allows a person to display their medical history in one QR code and a separate QR code for medications to be scanned by a pharmacist's. The pharmacists can review the drugs one is currently taking, as well as a new prescribed one, for drug interaction. My Medical History-QR™ is the easiest way to add and carry your important medical history in a mobile phone. In addition you can add, edit and view any information that you enter. You and only you have control of what information is added and who can see it. Enter as much or as little information as you wish. My Medical History-QR™ can be lifesaving and the most important app in your phone. We urge everyone to always carry your medical history with you at all times.
